

## Referrals

The Early Intervention Referral form is here.

Any child age birth to three years with concerns about development may be eligible for services. These concerns may include:

- \*Difficulty speaking clearly or understanding language
- \*Behavior difficulties
- \*Diagnosed hearing and vision loss
- \*Difficulty with movement

Any child having a condition of birth such as:

- \*Premature birth
- \*Cerebral palsy
- \*Down syndrome
- \*Fetal Alcohol Syndrome
- \*Spinal bifida

Anyone who is concerned about a child's development may make a referral:

- \*Parents
- \*Nurses
- \*Grandparents
- \*Social workers
- \*Doctors
- \*Teachers
- \*Friends

Early Intervention Services may include one or more of the following:

- \*Speech-language therapy
- \*Physical therapy
- \*Occupational therapy
- \*Developmental therapy
- \*Audiology
- \*Assistive technology

- \*Medical diagnostic services
- \*Nursing services
- \*Nutrition services
- \*Parent Liaison services
- \*Social work services
- \*Service coordination
- \*Special instructions
